### 1. Correspondence

### 2. Garden Waste collection. Information from Herefordshire Council via Cllr Carole Gandy.

The service was opened to sign-ups on Wednesday 22 October 2025, and Herefordshire Council welcomes subscriptions from residential properties across the county. ### 3. Updates on actions

- a) Drain in orchard by Ballsgate Lane. Reported 18 October. Update (requested) 10 November *“I have taken a look at your enquiry number, and I can see that a job was raised by the Locality Steward (41717616). Unfortunately, no date has been provided yet, for when the works are going to be completed; other than an estimated time of mid November.”*
- b) Update from Traffic Management regarding pneumatic tubes in Aymestrey – received 22 October. *“Unfortunately, we have experienced some delays in receiving the full set of survey data from the contractor for the surveys carried out across Herefordshire at the end of July. While we have now received the majority of the data, a few results are still outstanding. One of these is Aymestrey, which will need to be re-surveyed due to a data failure.*  
  
*I expect to receive the remaining information shortly, at which point I’ll be able to provide you with the complete dataset for Aymestrey, rather than sending partial updates.”*
