

Aymestrey Parish Council Information Sheet April 2026

1. **Vacancy.** Applications for co-option are welcomed. Please contact the clerk for further information or download the application form from the Parish Council website [www.aymestrey.org](http://www.aymestrey.org).
2. Correspondence from residents
  - a. Could support be given in progressing works on Ballsgate Lane/Lye Road. There is a fair amount of traffic, both residential, agricultural and forestry based, including large commercial vehicles. Users do not have any alternative routes to access houses and fields all along this road to Lower Lye, Upper Lye, through to Cross of the Tree and the route to Lyepole Bridge and Covenhope.  
Note: The resident will also report via the Balfour Beatty only system.
3. Verge cutting. Balfour Beatty advised that, for those that requested two cuts last year, the first cut will be scheduled in early April. Note: Aymestrey Parish Council requested one cut, in late summer/early autumn.
4. Hedge overhanging pavement on the A4110, Aymestrey village. The Parish Council will wish to express its thanks to the landowner for proactively trimming the hedge, which has resulted in a significant improvement in pedestrian safety.
5. Lengthsman. Agreement and Annual Maintenance Plan returned to Herefordshire Council on 29 March.
6. Aymestrey Parish Hall. Confirmed that the phone box will be monitored, ensuring its general tidiness. 29 March.
