Has the summer and sun ended. I know we have had a dry summer, but now the rain has moved in and winter approaches, witnessed by a very frosty last weekend.

Mortimer Trail, (Steps.)

The steps below Pokehouse Wood have now been refurbished and safe to use. Further work is needed on a second flight of steps, and this will complete the necessary work.

Mortimer Trail. (Lyepole to Ballsgate.)

Clearance of two trees blocking the footpath and strimming the vegetation has opened the Trail and makes a very pleasant walk along the River Lugg.

AY15.

The Stile on the left of the road as you go from Yatton towards Leinthall Earles has been replaced with a Gate

AY16.

A second Gate has replaced the Stile on the left of the same road which gives access to Leinthall Common.

Mortimer Trail. (Lyepole to Shobdon Wood.)

The steep footpath heading up to Shobdon Wood from the road near Lyepole is currently being strimmed and is ongoing. Hopefully completed today.

Mortimer Trail. (Yatton Hill Common.)

The Stile on the Trail is next due to be replaced with a Gate. Just waiting for my vehicle to get an MOT and service.

AY1.

Again, the section heading from the Aymestrey Hall and West to Mantle Cottage has been strimmed and nettle and encroaching trees have been strimmed.

Orleton Volunteers.

A group of volunteers have made themselves available for any work clearing path throughout Herefordshire. I have yet to meet them but will do so when help is needed on any work projects.
